# Tongan Recipes

## Kalua Pulled Pork Sandwiches

Yield: 50    Portion: 4 oz	
Ingredients	Instruction
15 lb. Pork 7 Tbsp Liquid Mesquite Smoke 19 Tbsp Kosher Salt	Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Make several slashes along the surface of the pork butt. Rub with salt, then with liquid smoke.
30 Ti Leaves Aluminum Foil	Prepare ti leaves by removing the rib. Wrap ti leaves around the pork until covered. Wrap aluminum foil tightly around the pork to make a watertight seal.
	Place in large roasting pan. Fill with two inches of water and cover pan tightly with foil. Bake at 350 degrees for 1 hour. Lower temperature to 325 degrees and cook for 3 hours or until tender. Unwrap pork and shred.
50 Hamburger Buns	Place 4.5 oz of pork on each bun.

## Faikakai Topai (Dumplings in coconut syrup)

Yield: 50    Portion: 4 oz	
Ingredients	Instruction
Syrup: 4 $\frac{3}{4}$ cups Sugar 1 gallon & 1 pint Coconut Cream	Put the sugar in a heavy saucepan and melt over gentle heat. Before the sugar boils, add the coconut cream and stir continuously until thick.
Water	Boil water in a large pot.
19 cups Flour 19 tsp Baking Powder	Sift flour and baking powder together. Combine with small amount of water.
	Drop tablespoons of dough into the boiling water and gently boil for 10 minutes.
	Dice the dumplings and pour the syrup over them.
